THE COMPETITION IS PLAYED ACCORDING TO THE CURRENT EDITIONS OF THE FOLLOWING:

Rules of Golf, LETAS Terms and regulations, LETAS Hard card 2026, Manual for the current competition, Additional Local Rules and any additional term of competition.

These Local Rules and Terms of Competition supersede all other local rules.

Unless otherwise noted, the **penalty for breach of a Local Rule** is the General Penalty. Strokeplay: **Two strokes**

ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

1. Penalty areas (Rule 16)

- a. Red penalty areas (RPA) with the opposite side same distance lateral relief this week: NONE
- b. The red penalty areas to the left of hole 4 and 17, and to the right of hole 10 are infinite.

2. Special Relief Procedures

a. Preferred lies (Model Local Rules E-3)

When any part of a player's ball touches part of the general area cut to fairway height or less the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area: Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.

Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: **one scorecard** from the reference point, but with these limits:

Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

3. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16.1)

a. Ground under repair

- 1. Large or hard ant hills on the course are, at the player's option, loose impediments that may be removed under Rule 15.1 or ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

EVACUATION PLAN

In case of suspension/resumption of play by the Committee the following signals will be used:

Immediate suspension of play: One prolonged blast of siren

Suspension of play: Three short blasts of siren, repeated

Resumption of play: Two short blasts of siren, repeated

When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation, the players **must** discontinue play immediately and not resume it until the Committee has ordered play to resume. When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation the players shall walk as fast as they can to the clubhouse, the halfway house or to the designated spots for a buggy, depending on their position on the course.
