Additional Local Rules

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a local Rule is the General Penalty (Two strokes).

Preferred Lies

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or, the player may prefer the lie within one scorecard length. See Model Local Rule E-3 for details of how this must be done.

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- Out of bounds is defined by white posts and white lines. Where both white posts and white lines exist the white line defines the boundary of the course.
Exception: To left of hole 8 and to the right of hole 11 and hole 12, white posts show the out of bounds. Out of bounds is defined by the line right below the electrical wire closest to the ground.
- Electric boundary fence. Model Local Rule E-7 is in effect:
If a player's ball lies on the course and within two club-lengths of the electric boundary fence the player may take free relief using the procedure in Rule 16.1 but based on this reference point: The point that is two club lengths from the fence and an equal distance from the hole to the spot of the original ball.
- Internal Out of Bounds:
Hole 4: To the right towards hole 1
Hole 8: To the right towards hole 15
Internal Out of Bounds is defined by white/black posts. The posts are boundary posts when playing hole 4 and 8 and immovable obstructions when playing any other hole.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

The red penalty areas;

- to the left of hole 1 and behind of hole 2,
 - to the left of hole 5 and
 - to the left and behind the green of hole 6
- extends to infinity.

3. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16.1)

- a. Ant hills on the course are, at the player's option, loose impediments that may be removed under Rule 15.1 or ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
- b. Young trees identified by supporting stakes are abnormal course conditions. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1.

4. Caddies (Rule 10.3)

Model Local Rule H-1.1 is in effect: A player must not have a caddie during the round.

5. Prohibiting use of motorised push cart/trolley

During a round, a player must not use any form of motorized push cart/trolley.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:

The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which there is a breach of this Local Rule. If the breach occurs between the play of two holes, it applies to the next hole.
